

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Wearing school uniform is compulsory. Its proper use creates a positive climate for school life.

- ▶ The school will notify students of any seasonal changes in the uniform (autumn/winter-spring/summer).
- ▶ Students will not be permitted onto the school premises if not wearing full school uniform.
- ▶ All items must be labelled with the student's name.

Sports kit is also required from year 1 of Primary.

Uniform description

Girls' uniform

- Plaid skirt (SEK model)
- White blouse
- Grey trousers
- White polo shirt (SEK model) for the spring and summer months and white shirt in winter
- Navy blue V-neck jumper (SEK model)
- Blue socks or tights
- Blue or black shoes
- Coat, preferably navy blue

Boys' uniform

- Grey trousers
- White polo shirt (SEK model) for the spring and summer months
- Navy blue V-neck jumper (SEK model)
- White shirt and SEK tie in winter
- Navy blue socks
- Blue or black shoes
- Blue or black belt
- Coat, preferably navy blue

Sports kit

▶ Early Childhood Education Stage 2 - Preschool (3 to 6 years old)

- White trainers (with rubber soles)

▶ Primary School

- Tracksuit (SEK model, students of Primary 1 should wear the tracksuit on Physical Education days, 2 days per week)
- Shorts (SEK model) and short-sleeve t-shirt (SEK model)
- White trainers (youngest students preferably without laces) and socks of the same colour
- Swimming costume and cap (SEK model) from Primary 3 to 6
